Events from Q1 and our impact..



Unlocking the Future of Sustainability in Developing Countries through the Impact Transparency African series workshop in Ghana by the GSG.

Ghanaian policymakers, investors, businesses etc were equipped with the knowledge and tools needed to navigate the evolving landscape and future implications of sustainability disclosure standards for emerging economies as ours at the "Understanding Sustainability Disclosure Standards and their Impact on Ghana" workshop. The event was organised by Impact Investing Ghana (IIGh), The Global Steering Group for Impact Investments (GSG) and The Institute of Chartered Accountants Ghana with support from the PAN AFRICAN FEDERATION OF ACCOUNTANTS, UNDP Ghana, IFRS Foundation's International Sustainability Standards Board (ISSB), and the UK Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office in Feb 2024. The dialogue also gathered feedback from stakeholders to inform the future development of global sustainability standards. IIGH, WUSC advance Gender Lens Investing and collaborations between Women's Rights Organisations and Investors in Ghana

As part of our goal to advance gender equality in Ghana, Impact Investing Ghana and the World University Service of Canada,(WUSC) brought together investors, Womens Rights Organisations (WROs), Civil Society Organisations (CSOs), and government stakeholders to explore how they could collaborate especially in using the data and insights from the WRO movement to inform the design and delivery of products to contribute to gender equality. <u>Read more here</u> and <u>contact us</u> to learn how you can support this work.

100 Pension Trustees equipped to invest in alternative assets.

Impact Investing Ghana in collaboration with Axis Pension Trust and Savanna Institute for Innovative Finance and with support from the Ford Foundation held a training session on "Evaluating Alternative Investments" in Accra. This workshop hosted by Axis, a pension trustee demonstrates the evolution of the ecosystem since 2021 where there was little interest in alternative assets to the current situation where a pension trustee is willing to fund capacity building on the subject. The session equipped attendees with the knowledge and skills needed to evaluate alternative investments and valuable insights to empower them to make informed decisions in their investment journeys. The interactive session which included case studies from Ghana and similar contexts and experiential learning, enabled trustees to gain hands-on experience of some of the key drivers of success and failure in alternative investments. This is part of a broader program to develop a comprehensive curriculum for Ghanaian pensions to equip them to successfully invest in alternative assets. <u>Contact us</u> to partner on this initiative.
